

BREA BEAD WORKS

FLORAL BUTTERCUPS

MATERIALS

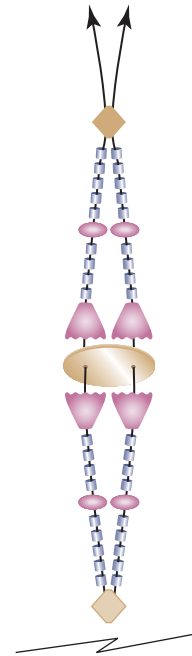
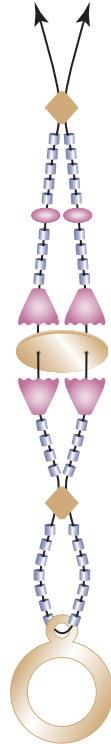
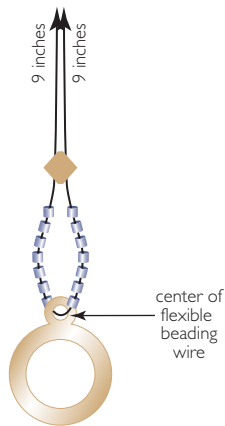
- ▷ Seed beads; 15° [2 grams]
- ▷ Bellflower glass beads; 4x6mm [16 qty]
- ▷ Donut glass beads; 2x4mm [14 qty]
- ▷ Bicone bead or crystal; 4mm [5 qty]
- ▷ Round metal connector; 2-holes [4 qty]
- ▷ Toggle clasp [1 qty]
- ▷ Flexible beading wire; .012" dia [18 inches]
- ▷ Tubular crimp bead; 2x2mm [1 qty]
- ▷ Crimp cover; 3mm [1 qty] *optional*
- ▷ Jump rings; 4mm open [3 qty]

TOOLS

- ▷ Crimping pliers
- ▷ Wire cutter
- ▷ Chain nose pliers; *optional*



ladder stitch

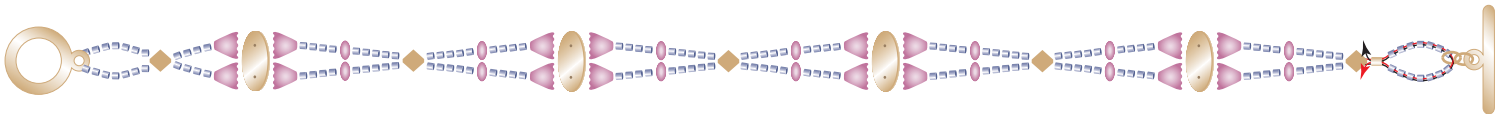


1. Use at least 18 inches of beading wire and string on toggle end and position at center of beading wire length. On each wire string on 7 seed beads. With wires together string on a bicone bead. Be sure that wire is similar in length.

2. On each wire string on 4 seed beads, bellflower, metal connector, bellflower, 4 seed beads, donut bead, 5 seed beads. Metal connector is common for both sides. With wires together string on a bicone bead.

3. On each wire string on 5 seed beads, donut bead, 4 seed beads, bellflower, metal connector; bellflower; 4 seed beads, donut bead, 5 seed beads. Metal connector is common for both sides. With wires together string on a bicone bead.

Repeat this step two more times.



4. End by stringing on a crimp bead over both wires and seven seed beads on each wire. Pass each wire through opposite seed beads to create a loop and back through crimp bead. Pull wires snug and crimp bead. Trim excess wires and cover crimp bead with crimp cover if desired. Attach toggle using open jump rings.
