

BREA BEAD WORKS

CRAWLING IVY BRACELET

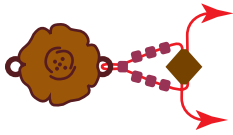
MATERIALS

- ▷ Bicone crystal; 4mm; color A [36 qty]
- ▷ Bicone crystal; 4mm; color B [10 qty]
- ▷ Chaton montees; 4mm [9 qty]
- ▷ Clasp of your choice [1 qty]
- ▷ Curved metal links; 7mm [36 qty]
- ▷ Seed beads; 11° [1 color]
- ▷ Flexible beading wire; .015" dia [40 inches]
- ▷ Tubular crimp bead; 2mm [1 qty]

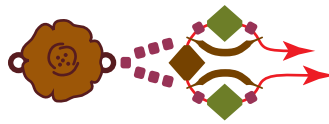
TOOLS

- ▷ Crimping plier
- ▷ Wire Cutter

ladder stitch variation



1. Start with a piece of flexible beading wire that is 40" long. Thread through one end of clasp and position at center of wire. With wires together, string on a seed bead. Separate wires and string on three seed beads on each wire. Using ladder stitch, pass each wire through a 4mm bicone (color B) but from opposite ends.



2. On each wire string on a metal link, seed bead, 4mm bicone (color A), seed bead, and pass through other end of metal link.

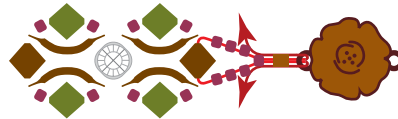
MAKE SURE YOUR CURVED METAL LINK IS FACING WITH THE CURVE INWARD.



3. Pass each wire through a chaton montee. Do not cross wires.



4. On each wire string on a metal link, seed bead, 4mm bicone, seed bead, and pass through other end of metal link. Using ladder stitch, pass each wire through a 4mm bicone (color B) but from opposite ends.



5. Try to end your bracelet with the 4mm bicone (color B), if possible. On each wire string on three seed beads. With wires together string on one seed bead, tubular crimp bead, and other end of clasp. Crimp securely and trim excess wire.

REPEAT STEPS 2-4 UNTIL YOU'VE REACHED YOUR DESIRED LENGTH. KEEP IN MIND THAT YOUR CLASP WILL ADD ABOUT ONE INCH TO YOUR BRACELET LENGTH.
