PEYOTE DREAMCATCHER PENDANT

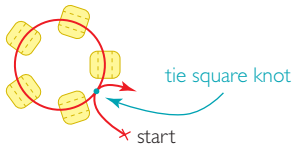
MATERIALS

- ▷ 11° seed beads [2 or more colors]
- ▷ 15° seed beads [1 or more color]
- ▷ 3mm bicones [10 qty]
- ▷ 4mm bicones [10 qty]
- ▷ Fireline thread; 6 lb

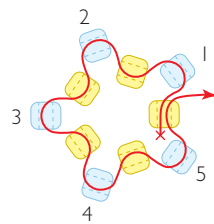
TOOLS

- ▷ Beading needles; size 12
- ▷ Scissors

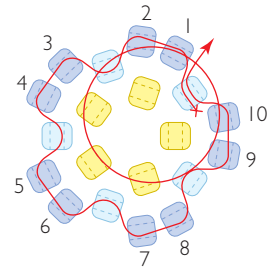
circular peyote



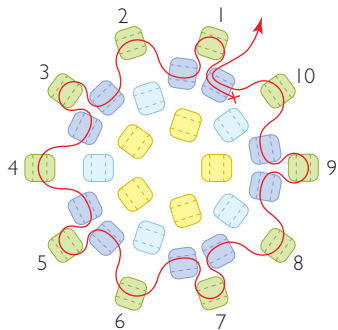
1. Start with 4' Fireline 6lb thread on a size 12 needle. String on (5) 11° seed beads (SB) and tie a square knot, forming a circle of beads, making sure you leave about 6" of tail thread.



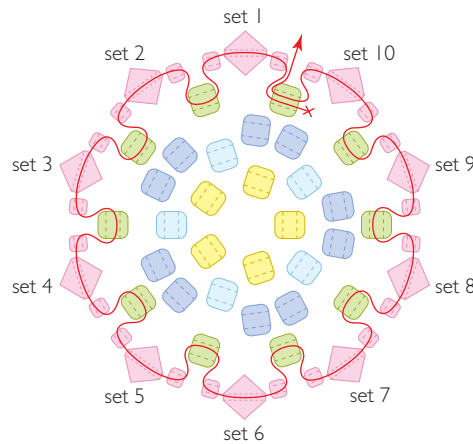
2. Pass needle through next 11° SB. String on a 11° SB, pass through next first row SB and repeat until you have added 5 SBs making up the second circular row.



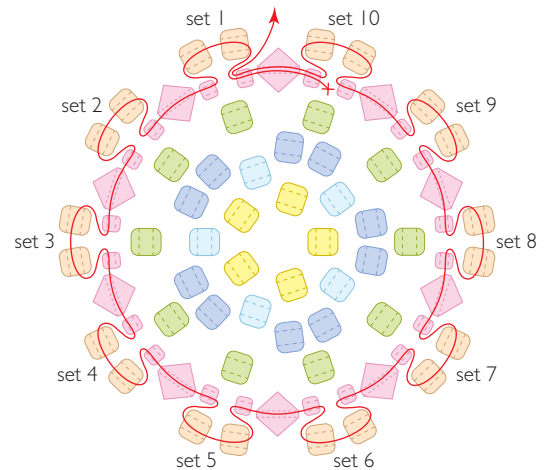
3. Pass needle through next 11° SB in the second row. Add two 11° SB, pass through next second row SB and repeat until you have added 10 SBs making up the third circular row.



4. Pass needle through next 11° SB in the third row. Add a 11° SB, pass through next third row SB and repeat until you have added 10 SBs making up the fourth circular row.



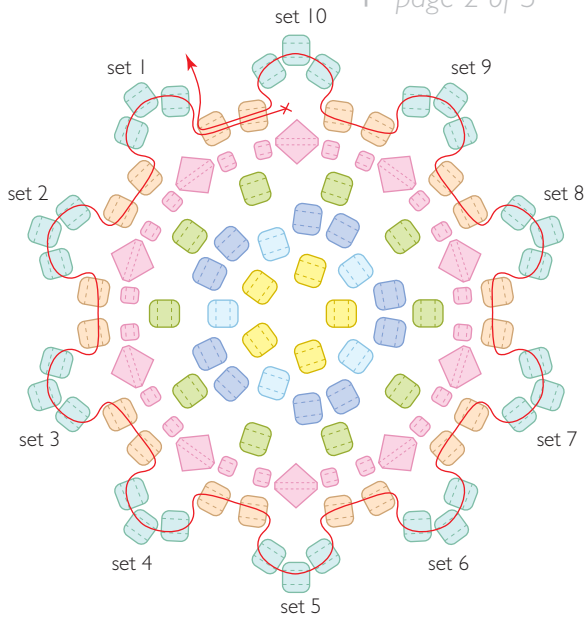
5. Pass needle through next 11° SB in the fourth row. Add a 15° SB, 3mm bicone, and 15° SB and pass through next fourth row SB and repeat until you have added 10 sets of beads making up the fifth circular row.



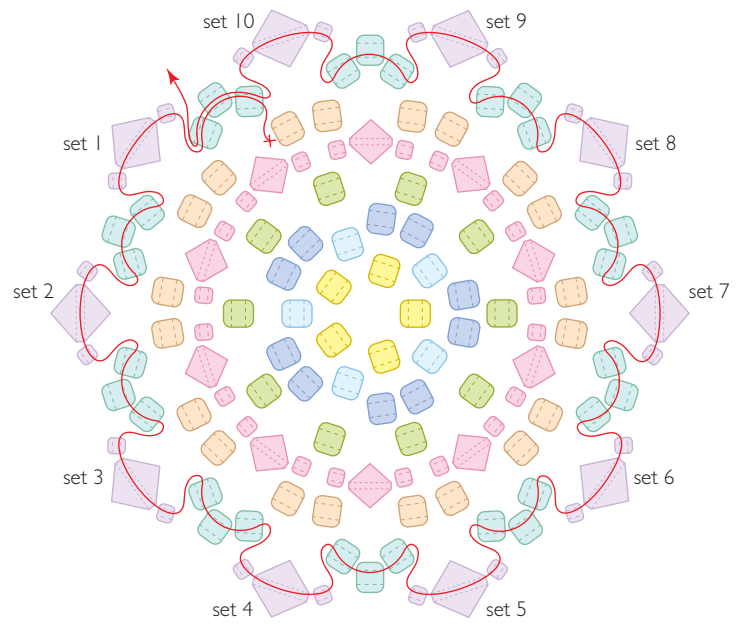
6. Pass needle through next 15° SB, 3mm bicone, 15° SB set of beads in the fifth row. Add two 11° SB and pass through the next 3 bead set in fifth row. Repeat until you have added 10 sets of SBs making up the sixth circular row.

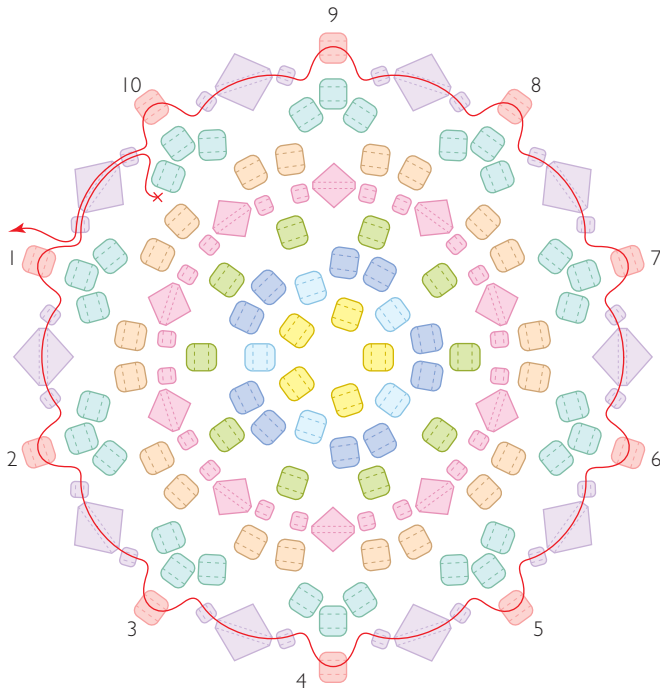




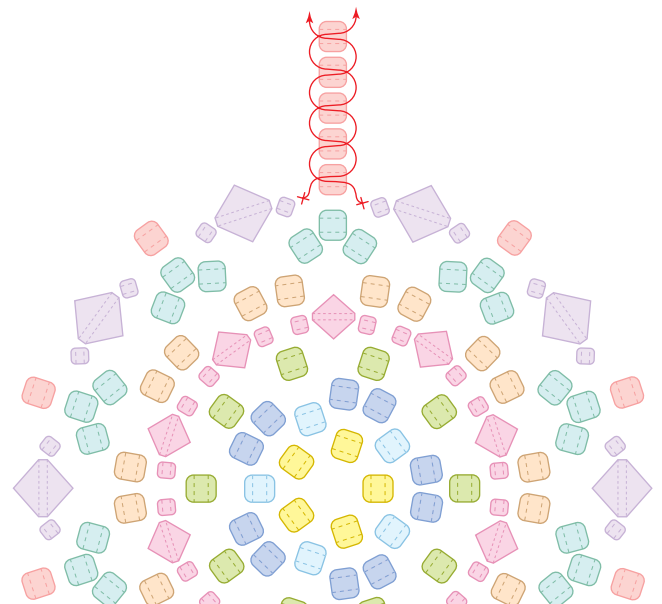
7. Pass needle through next two 11° SB set in the sixth row. Add three 11° SB and pass through the next two 11° SB set in the sixth row. Repeat until you have added 10 SB sets making up the seventh circular row.



8. Pass needle through next three 11° SB set in the seventh row. Add a 15° SB, 4mm bicone, and 15° SB and pass through next seventh row SB set and repeat until you have added 10 sets of beads making up the eighth circular row.



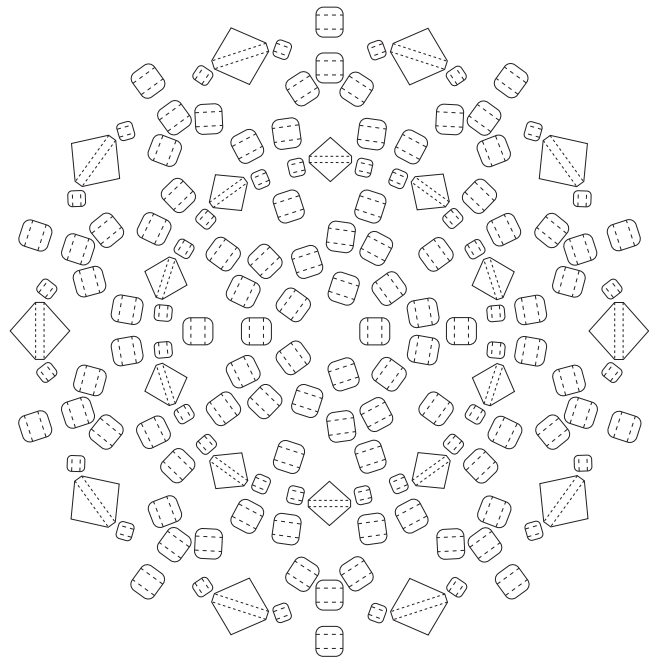
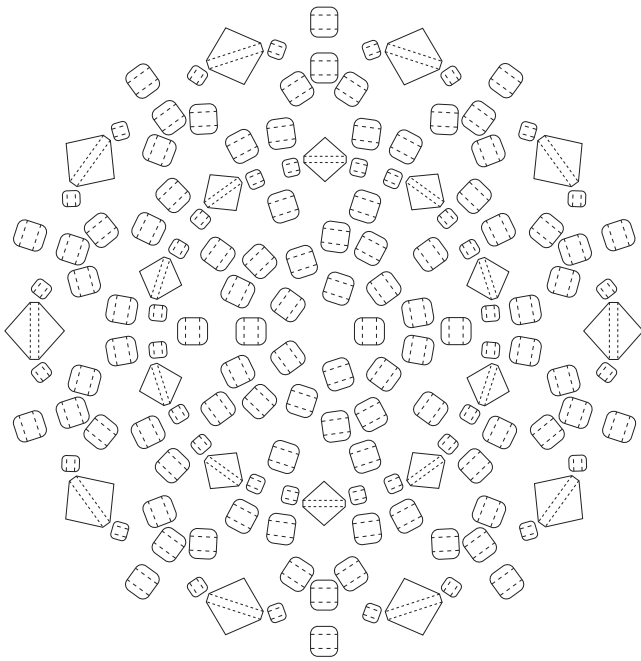
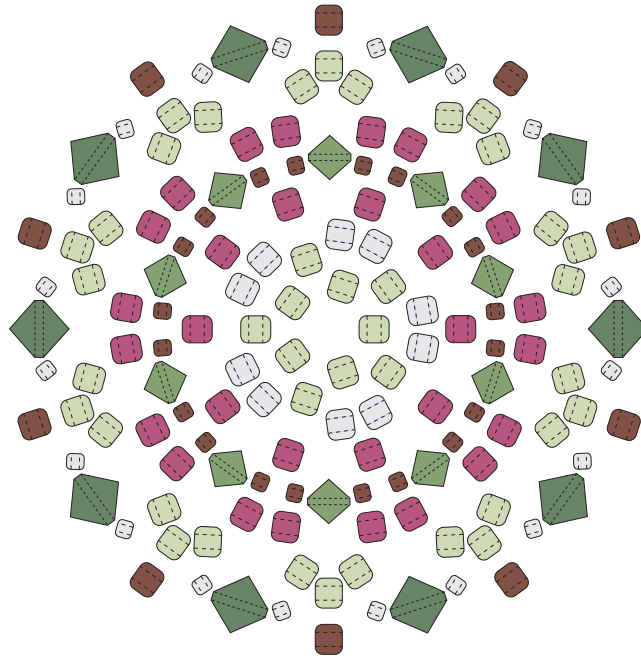
9. Pass needle through next 15° SB, 4mm bicone, 15° SB set of beads in the eighth row. Add one 11° SB and pass through the next 3 bead set in eighth row. Repeat until you have added 10 SBs making up the ninth, and final, circular row.



10. End thread by tying half-hitched knots in 4 locations and trim. Do the same for your tail end. To make the bail, ladder stitch 11° SBs and form a loop starting from an outer 11° SB.
