



# Garden Lattice

## MATERIALS

- (70+) teardrop, dagger, or petal beads; tip drilled
- (20+) leaf beads; tip drilled
- (20+) flower beads; with shank
- (3') beading wire; .014" diameter
- (1) tubular crimp bead
- (1) 3mm metal bead (optional)
- Clasp of your choice
- Wire cutter
- Crimping plier



1. Thread loop end of toggle (or one end of clasp of choice) on beading wire. Position at the middle of wire.



2. Thread a teardrop bead on both wires.



3. Separate wires and thread one teardrop and one leaf on left side. Thread two teardrops on right side. Thread both wires through a flower bead; from opposite ends.



4. Thread two teardrops on left side. Thread one teardrop and one leaf on right side. Thread both wires through a flower bead; alternate facing directions of flower. Repeat steps 3 and 4 until desired length.



5. End with the teardrops and leaf segment and thread a bead (your choice) through both wires to bring wires back together.



6. Thread a crimp bead and clasp end. Tighten up any slack in the wire and crimp securely. Test the strength of your crimp by tugging and then trim excess wire. *Congratulations!* ♦
