PASTEL PAISLEY BRACELET

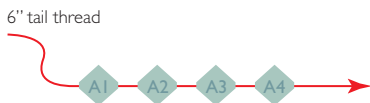
right-angle weave

MATERIALS

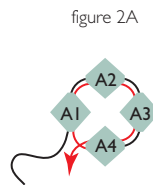
- ▷ Bicone crystal; 4mm [97 qty]
- ▷ Pearls; 4mm [11-12 qty]
- ▷ Seed beads; 15° [1 color]
- ▷ Button; 20mm [1 qty]
- ▷ Paisley charms [12 qty] *optional*
- ▷ Clasp of your choice [1 qty]
- ▷ Fireline thread; 6 lb

TOOLS

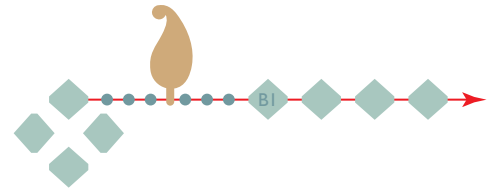
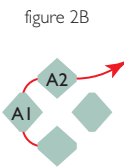
- ▷ Beading needle; size 12
- ▷ Scissors or Thread Zapper



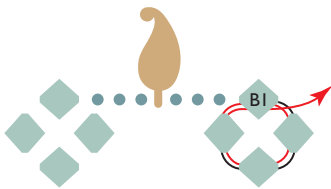
1. Cut and condition 6 feet of thread. Needle on four bicones.



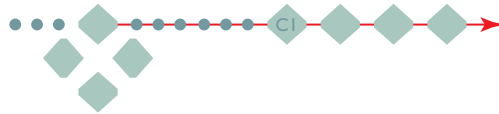
2. Go back through all four bicones leaving 6-inches of tail thread. Exit from bicone A4 (figure 2A). Needle through bicones A1 and A2 (figure 2B).



3. Needle on three 15° SB, charm, three 15° SB, and four bicones.



4. Go back through all four bicones and pull snug. Exit from bicone B1.



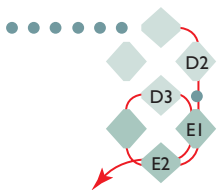
5. Needle on six 15° SB and four bicones.



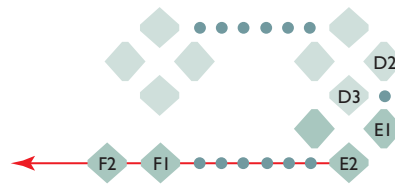
6. Go back through all bicones and pull snug. Exit from bicone C1.



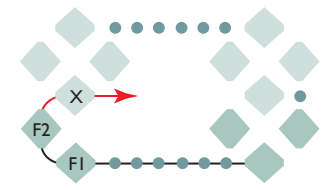
7. Repeat steps 3-6 ten more times until you have this pattern sequence. You should have six charm segments and six non-charm segments. You have completed one side of the bracelet length.



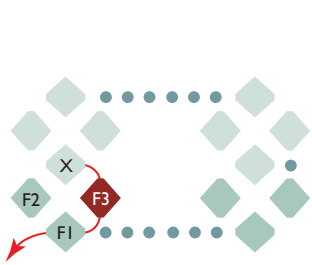
8. Continue stitching other side by needling through to bicone D2. Needle on one 15° SB and three bicones. Needle through D3 bicone from first row and back through new bicones E1 and E2. Pull thread snug.



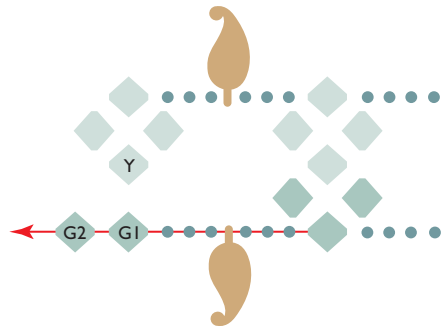
9. Needle on six 15° SB and two bicones.



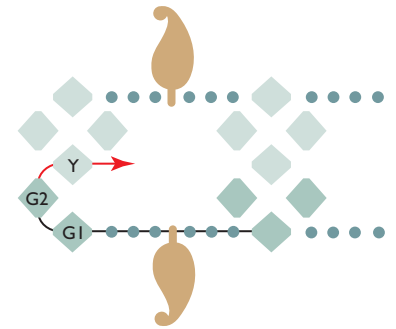
10. Needle through X bead from first row.



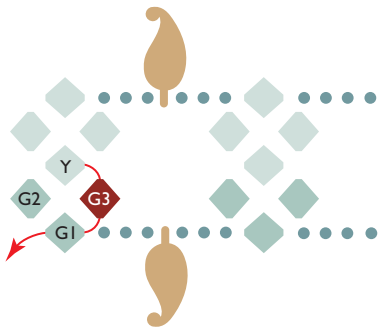
11. Needle on one bicone and pass through bicone F1.



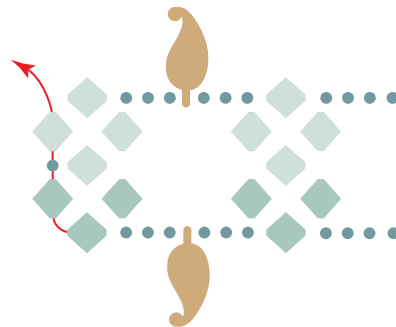
12. Needle on three 15° SB, charm, three 15° SB, and two bicones.



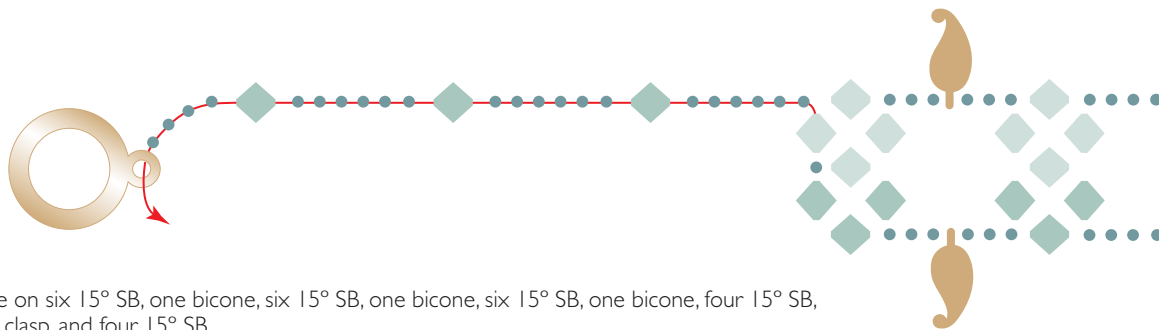
13. Needle through Y bead from first row.



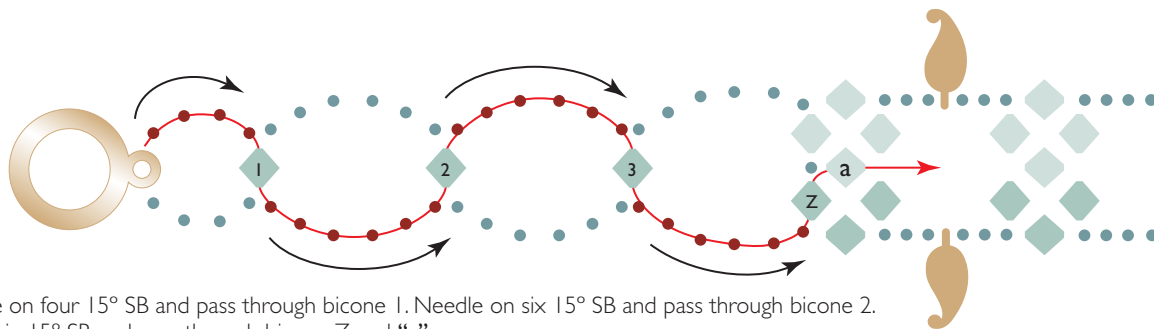
14. Needle on one bicone and pass through bicone G1. Repeat steps 10-14 until you have reached the other end.



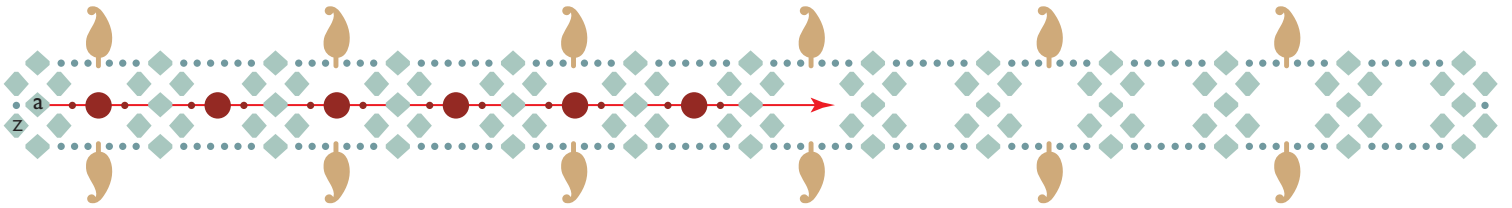
15. When finished with last set, needle straight through to first row, adding a 15° SB between rows.



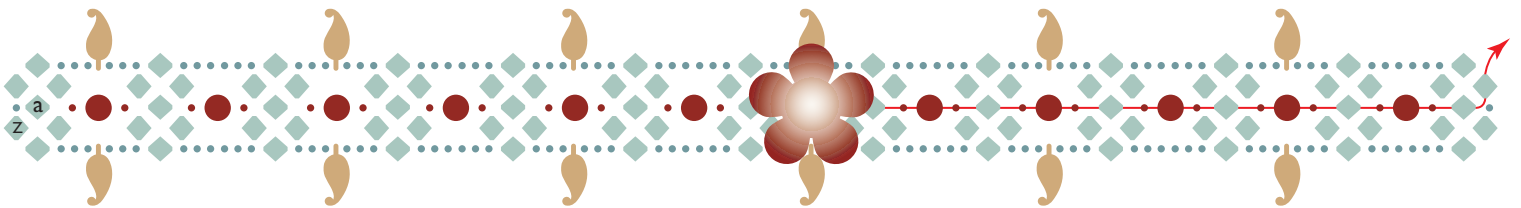
16. Needle on six 15° SB, one bicone, six 15° SB, one bicone, six 15° SB, one bicone, four 15° SB, one end of clasp, and four 15° SB.



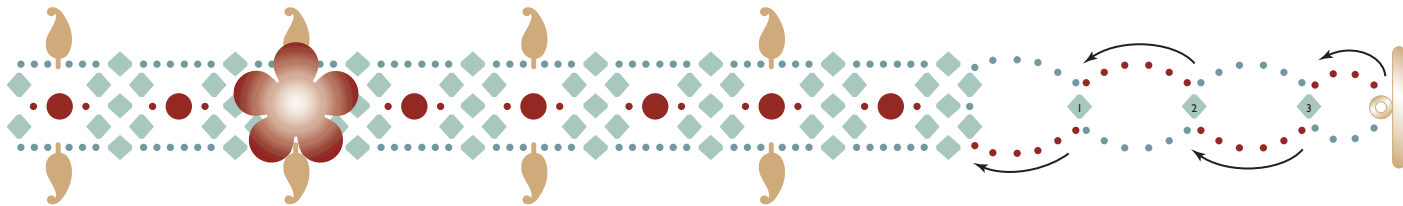
17. Needle on four 15° SB and pass through bicone 1. Needle on six 15° SB and pass through bicone 2. Needle on six 15° SB and pass through bicone Z and "a".



18. Needle on one 15° SB, one pearl, one 15° SB and pass through following bicone. Repeat this five more times for a total of six pearls.



19. Needle on three 15° SB, button, and three 15° SB. Pass through following bicone and continue adding SB, pearl, SB like in step 18, until you reach the end.



20. Needle on six 15° SB, one bicone, six 15° SB, one bicone, six 15° SB, one bicone, four 15° SB, and the other end of clasp. Repeat step 17 to create loops.

Weave thread back through to other end of bracelet through the center pearl path. Tie thread ends together using a square knot. Weave thread tails back into bracelet tying half-hitched knots in several locations and trim excess thread.
