uv resin charms

MATERIALS

- ▷ TierraCast frame charms [3 qty]
- ▷ TierraCast hammered ring; 1" dia [1 qty]
- ▷ MagicGlos resin
- ▷ Toothpicks
- ▷ Large loop chain [2 feet]
- ▷ Jump rings; 4-5mm open [17 qty]
- ▷ Clasp of your choice [1 qty]

TOOLS

- ▷ Flat nose pliers
- ▷ Chain nose pliers
- ▷ Wire cutters
- ▷ UV lamp; *optional*



1. Create or print out images that you would like to make into charms. If printing from an ink jet printer please fix the ink by spraying a fine mist of fixative or aerosol hair spray. Let dry completely.



2. Cut images to fit and set in frame.

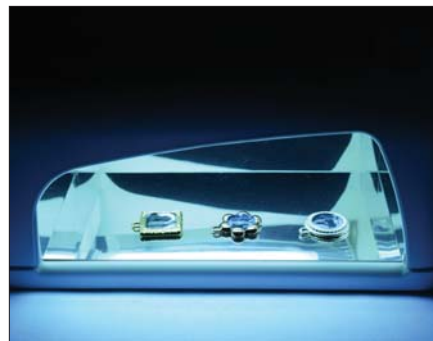


3. Slowly squeeze MagicGlos onto image from the center. Apply in thin layers to avoid bubbling. If bubbling does occur, remove air bubble by holding a lighter above bubble until it rises and pops.



4. Use a toothpick to push resin to edges of frame. This is a self doming resin and it will typically stop spreading once it reaches a boundary like the charm edge.

Repeat for other two charms.



5. Carefully place charms in UV lamp and cure for about 15 minutes. You may also cure in natural sunlight for about 30-40 minutes. When curing outside in natural sunlight, cover charms with a glass dish to protect it from dust.



6. Attach charms to large ring using open jump rings. Dangle charms at different lengths so each charm is exposed. Finish by attaching chain and clasp using open jump rings.

Now it's ready to wear!
