

BREA BEAD WORKS

VINTAGE ROSEBUDS BRACELET

right-angle weave



MATERIALS

- ▷ Bicone crystal; 4mm; color A [20 qty]
- ▷ Bicone crystal; 4mm; color B [20 qty]
- ▷ Bicone crystal; 4mm; color C [9 qty]
- ▷ Bicone crystal; 4mm; color D [10 qty]
- ▷ Seed beads; 11°; color A [5 grams]
- ▷ Seed beads; 11°; color B [2 grams]
- ▷ Clasp of your choice [1 qty]
- ▷ Fireline thread; 6 lb

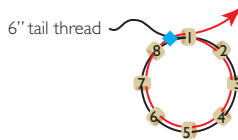
TOOLS

- ▷ Beading needle; size 12
- ▷ Scissors or Thread Zapper

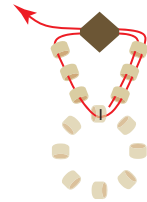
- BA - bicone color A*
- BB - bicone color B*
- BC - bicone color C*
- BD - bicone color D*
- SBA - seed bead color A*
- SBB - seed bead color B*



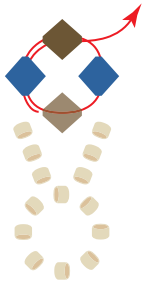
1. Thread needle with 8 feet of thread. Needle on 8 seed beads, color A (SBA).



2. Pass thread back through all 8 seed beads, leaving at least 6-inches of tail thread. Tie a square knot with the tail thread and working thread and then needle through first seed bead.



3. Needle on 3 SBA, 1 BA, and 3 SBA. Pass thread through seed bead 1 from previous loop, forming a loop, and continue through next 3 seed beads and bicone A.



4. Needle on 1 BB, 1 BA, and 1BB. Pass thread through original bicone A, forming a loop of crystals. Continue to pass thread through next two crystals, exiting out new bicone A.



5. Needle on 3 SBA, 1 BC, and 3 SBA. Pass thread through bicone A, forming a loop. Continue to pass thread through next three seed beads and exit out of bicone C.



6. Needle on 3 SBA, 1 BA, and 3 SBA. Pass thread through bicone C, forming a loop. Continue to pass thread through next three seed beads and exit out of bicone A.

Repeat steps 4 through 6 until you reach desired length. Remember that we still have to attach a clasp which adds about an inch to the length.

TRY TO END BRACELET ON FOUR CRYSTAL SEGMENT (STEP 4) IF POSSIBLE.

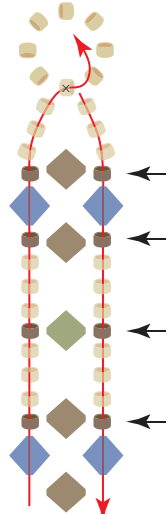
BA - bicone color A • BB - bicone color B • BC - bicone color C • BD - bicone color D • SBA - seed bead color A • SBB - seed bead color B



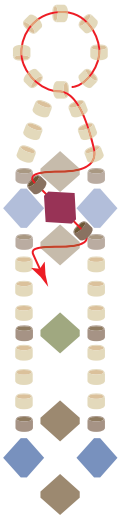
7. Needle on 7 SBA. Pass thread through bicone A, forming a loop. Continue to pass thread through next four seed beads.



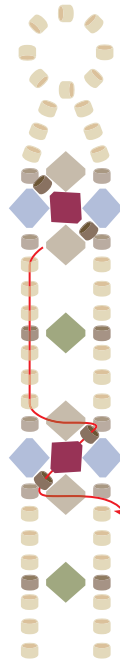
8. Needle on 7 SBA. Form end loop by passing thread through middle seed bead in previous segment ("x") and loop through again to reinforce. You should be exiting out of "x" seed bead.



9. Pass thread down one side adding seed bead color B in vacant spaces, before and after all bicones going down. Turn thread and do the same for other side.



10. Turn thread through end loop and continue to pass thread down one side and exit out of first bicone A. Needle on 1 SBB, 1 BD, 1 SBB. Create a diagonal path by passing thread through next bicone A but from opposite side.



11. Pass thread down the side seed beads, excluding the seed beads directly next to bicones. Pass through bicone A and needle on 1 SBB, 1 BD, 1 SBB. Create diagonal path by passing thread through next bicone A but from opposite side. Repeat steps 10-11 until you reach other end.



Half-Hitched Knot

12. End thread by tying half-hitched knots in several location and trim excess. Do the same for tail of thread end.

Add clasp to end loops using open jump rings.
